The Ponies raced out to a 3-0 lead before Erie scored six unanswered runs. Drew Gilbert clobbered a game-tying three-run homer in the sixth, but Erie took the lead back in the seventh and added two in the ninth. Rhylan Thomas went 2-for-4 with an RBI double and has recorded a hit in his last 15 overall games (12 regular season, 3 postseason). Rowdey Jordan went 2-for-4 and has recorded a hit in his last 11 overall games (8 regular season, 3 postseason). Erie leads the best-of-three series 1-0. The last time Binghamton won an Eastern League Championship was 2014, when it swept Richmond.

**Poststeason Ponies:** Binghamton has won three Eastern League championships in its history (1992, 1994, 2014). Binghamton won its first playoff series since 2014 with a sweep of Somerset in the best-of-three Division Series.

**Double-A All-Stars:** Right-hander **Christian Scott** was named to the Double-A Eastern League All-Star Team as a starting pitcher. Infielder **Luisangel Acuña** was named to the Double-A Texas League All-Star Team as a utility for his performance with the Frisco RoughRiders (Texas Rangers) before being traded to the Mets on July 30.

**2023 Mets Minor League Awards:** Five current members of the Rumble Ponies earned a 2023 Mets Minor League Award: **Jett Williams** - Minor League Player of the Year; **Christian Scott** - Minor League Pitcher of the Year; **AJ Sager** - Staff Member of the Year; **Hayden Senger** - Platinum Glove Award; **Rhylan Thomas** - Outfield Gold Glove Award. Additionally, **Ryan Orr** was named the Eastern League Strength Coach of the Year.

**Chilly Drew:** Outfielder **Drew Gilbert** crushed a game-tying three-run homer in the sixth inning of last night's ELCS Game 1. It was his second game-tying homer this month, with the other coming at Hartford on September 7 in the final frame as part of his two-homer game. Gilbert has four hits, three RBIs, and a run over his last two games.

**Jett Stream:** Shortstop **Jett Williams** was named the 2023 Mets Minor League Player of the Year. Williams drew a career-high-tying four walks and scored two runs in Game 1 of the ELCS on Monday. Williams' first Double-A homer was a three-run shot in Game 1 of the NEDS against Somerset. Williams is the first Mets Minor Leaguer with 100+ walks since 2013 and the first teenager to lead the organization in walks since David Wright in 2002. The 19-year-old is also the first Mets position player drafted out of high school to reach Double-A in the following calendar year since Gregg lefferies in 1986.

**Jordan's Brand:** Infielder/outfielder **Rowdey Jordan** has had a terrific postseason. Jordan has gone 6-for-12 over his first three postseason games this year, including a multi-hit game last night in Game 1 of the ELCS with a double and single and run scored. He has two doubles, two runs, an RBI, and a stolen base over the first three postseason games.

**Last Start:** Scott started the opening game of the Postseason last Tuesday at Mirabito Stadium against Somerset. He allowed one run, on a solo homer to Trey Sweeney, over 3 IP with 5 K/0 BB

Against Erie: Scott made two starts against Erie in the regular season in July and combined to strike out 14 batters with no walks over 11 innings of two-run ball.

**2022**: Scott made 18 appearances and nine starts across two levels at Class-A St. Lucie and High-A Brooklyn. He held a 3.80 ERA in his five starts and six appearances for the Cyclones last season. Across the two levels, Scott held a 77-to-22 K-to-BB ratio.

BACKGROUND: Scott was named the 2023 New York Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year. He was also selected to the 2023 Eastern League All-Star Team as a starting pitcher. Scott was drafted by the Mets in the fifth round of the 2021 draft out of the University of Florida. Scott made four starts for Peoria in the Arizona Fall League this past fall, alongside Rumble Ponies outfielder Brandon McIlwain and pitcher Mike Vasil. He currently ranks as the Mets' No. 12 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline. He totaled a 12-5 career record in 55 appearances and five starts with a 3.72 ERA, three saves, and 111 strikeouts across 121 innings pitched for the Gators across three seasons from 2019-2021. As a redshirt sophomore in 2021, Scott went made 26 appearances and one start going 4-2 with a 3.00 ERA and 51 strikeouts in 54 innings. He ranked in the top 10 in the SEC in appearances in 2021, leading the Gators. Led Calvary Christian Academy to the 2018 4A State Title in Floriday and was a First Team All-American selection by MaxPreps. Was a member of the USA Baseball 2016 17U National Team Development Program.

#### Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. -- Sager was named the 2023 Mets Minor League Staff Member of the Year. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.

**Darin Everson- Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 1st year in the Mets organization**. Everson spent the previous five seasons as the Colorado Rockies Hitting Coordinator and 10 years in the Rockies organization. Mariano Duncan - Bench Coach - 2nd season with Binghamton - 5th year with Mets organization. Duncan returns to the Southern Tier to begin his second year as Bench Coach with the Rumble Ponies. He previously served as the bench coach for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) in 2021. He is entering his fifth year in the Mets organization. The former infielder played 12 major league seasons with the Los Angeles Dodgers, Cincinnati Reds, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Toronto Blue Jays. He was a member of two World Series championship teams (1990 Cincinnati Reds, 1996 New York Yankees) and was inducted into the Dominican Republic Baseball Hall of Fame in 2008.
