Justin Verlander Making Rehab Start with Binghamton: New York Mets pitcher and three-time Cy Young Award winner Justin Verlander will make a rehab start Friday with the Binghamton Rumble Ponies. The reigning Cy Young Award winner and World Series champion signed a two-year contract with the Mets in December. Verlander is a two-time World Series champion and won the 2011 American League Most Valuable Player Award.

More on JV: Verlander is a nine-time all-star and is first among active pitchers with 244 career victories. He is also 13th all-time and second to Mets teammate Max Scherzer among active pitchers with 3,198 strikeouts. In 17 major league seasons, Verlander is 244-133 in 482 starts with a 3.24 ERA. He is just one of two players in major league history to be named Jackie Robinson Rookie of the Year (2006), Cy Young (2011, 2019, 2022), and Most Valuable Player (2011) joining Don Newcombe.

Matty O My: Matt O'Neill snapped an 0-for-20 skid with a go-ahead solo homer in Tuesday's series opener. O'Neill later smacked an RBI double. He drilled a gametying RBI double in the final frame of the second game of the doubleheader on Thursday. In the series, O'Neill has a homer, two doubles, three RBIs, and two runs.

Jose, Jose, Jose, Jose: Jose Peroza has a team-leading five hits in this series, with a home run, five RBIs, and two runs. He is 5-for-11 (.455) with a .455 OBP, .727 SLG, and 1.182 OPS. He had three hits and three RBIs in Tuesday's series opener and had a solo homer and an RBI single across the doubleheader on Thursday.

Double Dipping: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies split Thursday's double header with the Akron RubberDucks, dropping the first game 5-2 and winning the second game 4-3 in walk-off fashion. Mateo Gil deliverd a walk-off single into center to win the game in the eighth. Wyatt Young reached base five times in the doubleheader. It was the Ponies' first walk-off win of the year and first doubleheader.

Upcoming Schedule: Binghamton will continue its series with the RubberDucks on Saturday Mirabito Stadium with first pitch set for 1:05 PM. The game will be broadcast on WNBF News Radio 1290 AM and 92.1 FM, and MiLB.TV and the Bally Live App.

BACKGROUND: The 2011 American League Most Valuable Player joined the Mets this past offseason after a storied career with the Detroit Tigers (2005-17) and Houston Astros (2017-22). Verlander won his second World Series Championship with Houston in 2022 and was a unanimous selection for his third career American League Cy Young Award. The nine-time all-star is first among active pitchers with 244 career victories. He is also 13th all-time and second to Mets teammate Max Scherzer among active pitchers with 3,198 strikeouts. In 17 major league seasons Verlander is 244-133 in 482 starts with a 3.24 ERA. He is just one of two players in major league history to be named Jackie Robinson Rookie of the Year (2006), Cy Young (2011, 2019, 2022), and Most Valuable Player (2011) joining Don Newcombe.

2022: Verlander won his second World Series Championship with the Houston Astros last season, and was a unanimous selection for his third career American League Cy Young Award. He led the American League with 18 wins and led the major leagues with a 1.75 ERA. He led the majors with a 0.829 WHIP and finished 10th in American League MVP voting.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.

Darin Everson- Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 1st year in the Mets organization. Everson spent the previous five seasons as the Colorado Rockies Hitting Coordinator and 10 years in the Rockies organization. During his tenure, he served as the organization's Triple-A hitting coach in 2017, Double-A hitting coach from 2013-2014 and as the club's Double-A manager from 2015-2016. He previously was part of the Marlins organization for four years and served as an Associate Scout with the Baltimore Orioles from 2003-04. Everson played professionally as a catcher and first basemen for seven seasons with the Montreal Expos, Pittsburgh Pirates, and Boston Red Sox organizations.
